After serving two years in the Marine Corps, he began his education in 1959 ending with a Doctorate of Ministries in 1980. He served churches in North Carolina, Georgia and South Carolina. The last 10 years of ministry before retirement was in Charleston, SC, as Executive Director of Missions for Charleston Baptist Association. He retired in December, 1999.

Ralph Hefner is currently a member at New Hope Baptist Church, Seneca. He is the former Associate Pastor of Lee Road Baptist Church in Taylors, SC where he served in that capacity for 21 years. On March 7, 1997, Ralph entered the hospital for extensive back surgery that lasted over 13 hours. When he awoke the next morning in intensive care, he realized that he had lost his sight. Since that time, Ralph has allowed the Lord to lead him in many directions to share the sufficiency of God's grace during adversity.
