### Suggestions for Parents on Discipleship for all Ages!

Many of you have mentioned that teaching your child to read and love the Bible on their own is a hope of yours! This month's article will talk about how to do that!

#### Beneficial for all ages:

- · Having a family devotion time. Read a Bible Story together
- · Watch the weekly video of our Bible lesson again- sent via Band
- Let your child see you reading the Bible. Tell them that you're doing it and that you
  try to make it an important part of your day
- Listen to Christian music when you're in the car such as 89.3 or SIRIUS-XM Channel 63. There are also great premade playlists on Apple Music or Spotify!
- Watch videos at home about Christian values and Bible stories. You can find them on Minno's YouTube channel or streaming app or Angel Studios' FREE app!

#### Preschool:

Since preschoolers are just learning to read, picture Bibles that you read TOGETHER at bedtime are good for them.

Show them your Bible. Tell them how it is special to you and that all that is written in it is true because it is about God. Need a Bible of your own? Text Lauren for a suggestion and use the Bible app while you're waiting for it to arrive!

#### Elementary:

Based on your child's reading level, they may be able to read the Bible on their own (refer to April newsletter for how to select one). They can reread a story from Sunday School, C-Street Kids, or BQ-252! Text Lauren or their teacher if you need help remembering which story they studied in class!

A devotional guide such as Clubhouse Magazine or The Bible Recap for Kids is a great way to encourage your child to read their Bible throughout the week!
