Annual Church Planning ...

One of the ongoing processes of the church is our annual church planning that leads to daily, weekly, monthly reviews that help us coordinate, cooperate and communicate the work of the church body. We just finished annual church planning with both the church staff and the "Church Planning Team" (formerly called Church Council).

Most of the time those who are most actively involved in specific events have the most input into the plans and reviews. From year to year we change things, try new things and eliminate things to accomplish our goals and purposes.

With that said, here is a synopsis of this year's annual church planning process.

- 1. Annual Church-wide Picnic – Will be held again this year on August 30th but will be moved back to the church property. The reasoning is that many of our people are not comfortable walking the unlevel grounds of Biggerstaff and the parking conditions are not as good as they are here on the church grounds.**
- 2. Combining the two annual holiday meals into one – We felt that since the Thanksgiving and Christmas dinners were scheduled so close to each other that it would serve our church better to put all our emphasis into one meal, rather than dividing our efforts and energy twice. The Annual Christmas Dinner will be our focus this year. We will be asking each deacon to reach out to their families and arrange transportation to the dinner for those who do not get out at night or have trouble traveling. We have already enlisted a photographer and the Fellowship Team has agreed to provide the entire meal except for desserts.**
- 3. "Spring Fling Banquet" is scheduled for April 18 at 6:00 pm. Once again the Fellowship Team will take the lead in making this a wonderful evening of fellowship to help us break out of the winter blues and kick off the spring. Details will be coming.**
- 4. "Carolina Bronze" – We have already scheduled a wonderful Christmas Handbell Special for Sunday night, December 6.**
- 5. The name of the Fall Celebration has been changed back to "Fall Family Festival" and will continue to be held on Sunday afternoon from 3:00 – 5:00 pm.**

Annual planning involves much more than these few items. You can watch the newsletter, the bulletin, the announcement loop before worship, and email alerts from the church office for details and communication each month.

I remind us all that "We are a loving and compassionate family of God who prayerfully commit to go and bring people to Jesus Christ, teach people to be like Christ, show God's love by helping people and enjoy God in worship".

It's easy to tithe and give your offerings online!

Your tithes, offerings, and donations to College Street Baptist can now be made online. Tithing and donating have never been easier. It's quick, easy and secure and you can use debit or credit or check cards, or checking account. Just go to our website at www.collegestreetbaptist.org for further information and instructions.

Online giving is not replacing any of the traditional ways we already give, but is an additional option to those who prefer to make their donations by computer, cell phone or other mobile devices. College Street is using a church donation system provided by the Easy Tithe corporation. *EasyTithe* is church specific and is currently used by hundreds of churches across the nation.

You can make a regularly scheduled contribution or you can specify recurring donations. You can specify whether the contribution should go to the general budget or to designated categories. A credit card (MasterCard, Visa, or Discover) or a debit card can be used as well as a regular checking account. The process is secure and confidential and you will have continual access to your giving records.
